## AKC Government Relations

### LOCAL ISSUES

The Canyon Lake, CA City Council has rejected a proposed mandatory spay/neuter ordinance, but it is likely to return to the council once a new interim city manager is appointed.

The Chino Valley, AZ Town Council has returned to committee a proposal that would have enacted numerous problematic changes to the town's animal control laws. Provisions of concern included a requirement for a kennel permit, business license, and inspections for properties on which more than six dogs over the age of six months are permanently maintained; allowance for seizure and euthanasia on suspicion of neglect; and overly-broad "dangerous animal" provisions.

The Los Angeles Department of Animal Services has submitted a report to the city

council which recommends several changes to the city's breeding permits and spay/neuter ordinance. Changes include requiring sterilization on a second impoundment even if the animal has an intact license, removing the exemption for animals that have acquired a title or are being trained for conformation, companion or performance events and requiring that those seeking exemptions for show or competition animals provide verified proof of competition. Finally, the proposal would require those who have a breeding permit to be "subject to inspection by the Los Angeles Department of Animal Services at its sole discretion."

The Menifee City, CA Council has tasked an ad-hoc committee of two councilmembers to review language for a

## AKC's Taking Command

### The Legal Profession Weighs In: Repeal Breed-Discriminatory Ordinances

CHICAGO, August 9, 2012 – The American Bar Association's 560-member policymaking House of Delegates met during the ABA 2012 Annual Meeting in Chicago to discuss policies relating to a broad range of issues which are advocated for by state and local bar associations, specialty legal groups within the ABA or affiliated with the association, and individual members.

Among other policies, the House adopted the ABA Tort Trial & Insurance Practice Section's (TIPS) Resolution 100, which urges all state, territorial, and local legislative bodies and governmental agencies to adopt comprehensive breed-

neutral dangerous dog/reckless owner laws that ensure due process protections for owners, encourage responsible pet ownership and focus on the behavior of both dog owners and dogs, and to repeal any breed discriminatory or breed specific provisions.

According to Ledy VanKavage, Immediate Past Chair of the TIPS Animal Law Committee, "People love their pets, no matter what their appearance. This is America. Responsible pet owners should be allowed to own whatever breed they want. They should not have to live in fear of their pets being seized and killed simply because of their appearance."

possible ordinance to ban the sale of dogs and cats in the city.

The City of Chula Vista, CA will consider an ordinance to regulate "pet sellers," defined as those who sell two or more animals in a year. The proposal includes a requirement that pet sellers will allow animal control officers to inspect their homes if there is a complaint. The proposal does not address a seller's non-compliance or what remedies or penalties could be invoked.

#### FDA RECALL NOICES

### RECALL—POSSIBLE SALMONELLA RISK

September 11, 2012 - Breeder's Choice Pet Food is recalling a single batch of Breeder's Choice AvoDerm Natural Lamb Meal & Brown Rice Adult Dog Formula due to possible contamination with *Salmonella*. The only product affected by this recall is the 26# bag, SKU 1000065074 ;UPC 0 5290702043 8 ;and has the following "Best Before" dates: 28 Aug 2013, 29 Aug 2013 and 30 Aug 2013. Recalled products were distributed in the states of California, Georgia, Illinois, Nevada, Virginia, and Washington.

September 21, 2012 - Kasel Associated Industries of Denver, CO is voluntarily recalling its BOOTS & BARKLEY 6 COUNT 5 INCH AMERICAN BEEF BULLY STICKS product because it may be contaminated with *Salmonella*. The recalled product were distributed nationwide through Target retail stores from April through September 2012.

We seem to be in a patch of getting more girls than boys, lately. All rescue groups almost always have more boys than girls ... including us.

Little Holly was found wandering a Riverside neighborhood and a kind lady took her to her nearby groomer, who she thought would probably recognize her and know who her owner was. The groomer put up 'found dog' signs, ads in newspapers and signs at local shelters but no one called. After a month she called us and arrangements were made to pick her up. Our vet estimated that Holly was about two years old, when she went for her physical, spay, vaccines, teeth cleaning, and microchip.

She now lives in Pacific Palisades with her new Scottie 'brother,' Buddy, who was adopted from us about three years ago. "They are each other's shadows," her new mom happily told me. Buddy had been lonesome since his Poodle buddy had died this past Spring. Holly's new dad works from home while mom is a nurse practitioner who lives close enough to walk to work. "We take a long walk every night when I get home from work and they both get so much attention," she says.

Maxwell, about one year old, also came from the Riverside area, landing as a stray (lost dog) in the Riverside County shelter. No one claimed him and one of our dedicated helpers bailed him out and had



called to arrange to pick him up, they said they had just decided they'd like to keep

him and were going to call me that very day.

They'd lost two Scotties to age related issues in the last several years, though they still have three Westies. "Maxwell is sure not housebroken and he can somehow get over our baby gates, but we just love him," his new mom told me ... "and our Westies love him and he thinks he is one of them."

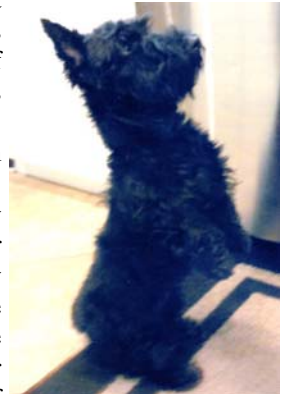
Our little one year old wheaten boy, Hamish, also came from the Riverside shelter. We had a great home in Bakersfield waiting for a male and even though this fellow, a community college teacher, already had a wheaten girl, he immediately made arrangements to adopt Hamish. He'd just lost a ten year old black Scottie girl to bladder cancer. When Hamish met Shamy, although it wasn't love at first sight, they did very well together.

"I took Hamish and Shamy for a three day weekend trip to San Francisco," he emailed me, "and boy did we get a lot of attention and questions everywhere we went. People were so surprised to see two wheatens," he happily told me. Hamish will be spending two months touring Europe next summer "I booked our trip in June on Cunard lines, which has a kennel area aboard ship." Lucky little Scotties!

And our newest girl, Lulu, came from the crowded, high kill Las Vegas Lied shelter. She is estimated to be about three years old and has one ear that does not stand. Our Las Vegas vet thought she most likely had a hematoma or ear infection that wasn't promptly or properly treated, sometime way in the past. Lulu was picked up by Animal Control responding to a dog bite report. She was impounded with a Pitbull, who was the dog that did the biting. She

was unclaimed and our Vegas helper bailed Lulu after her time was up for her owner to claim her.

Alex and Heather Chang, in Las Vegas for a business seminar, generously volunteered to bring her back to their home and foster her for us. I told Alex that Lulu would likely dominate their two males, Levi and Angus, and assert her position as alpha, and of course she has done just that. The boys seem fine with it, though. They have taken her everywhere they go. "All in all we are happy to be able to show her a different side of the world ... she's settling in and may never want to leave," Alex wrote me, last week.



"As she's been seeing more and more dogs in our neighborhood, I think she is getting more social and less wary of seeing people she doesn't know. I think she'll tolerate a home with other dogs but they'll always have to know that she's the boss," he added.

Becky, our little waif out of the Orange County shelter, who we wrote about last month, had several families interested in adopting her, both saying "She's just adorable," when I emailed them her photos. But her age of three was "too old" for one family .... and her small size, 15 pounds, was too small for the other. We know the perfect home is out there. She is a great lap sitter and an animated little Scottie girl.

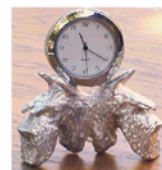

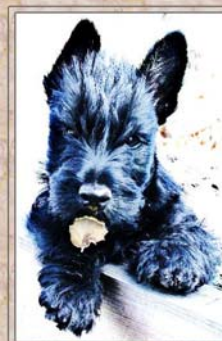
